



Our application for **PreseNEETi se** project, which addresses the problem of NEETs (young people not in employment, education or training), was successful at a call for proposals for co-financing of projects under the programme Education, Scholarships, Apprenticeship and Youth Entrepreneurship.

PreseNEETi se project is co-financed under the Norwegian Financial Mechanism 2014-2021 and will also receive national co-financing from Slovenia. The project total grant amount is 498.792,00 €. The objective of the project is the empowerment and social activation of NEETs. The project thus simultaneously contributes to the establishment of support services for NEETs and to an improved social environment and education designed especially to support disadvantaged groups.

The duration of the project is June 1 2022 - April 30 2024. Project partners are: Ljudska univerza Celje / University of Adult Education Celje, Univerza v Mariboru / University of Mariboru, Mladinski svet Slovenije / National Youth Council of Slovenia, Zavod RS za zaposlovanje / Employment Service of Slovenia and a Norwegian partner Veiledernetverket NOSCO / Norwegian Organisation for Supervision and Co-Operation.

Objectives:

- To empower and socially involve at least 30 NEETs in the labour market
- To include 40 mentors in a two-tier mentoring scheme
- To empower at least 100 stakeholders at the systemic level with a new methodology to identify the basic characteristics and needs of the NEET population and pave the way for the concept of early intervention

NOSCO is the responsible partner for Work package T1: Review and analysis of the current situation in the field of working with NEETs, identification and evaluation of best practices, preparing methodology for evaluation.

Work will be carried out in collaboration with University of Maribor.

NOSCO's tasks:

- Preparing an analysis of best practices of working with NEETs in Norway,
- Preparing a report of the analysis for Norway,
- Organizing a trip in Norway for Slovenian partners: meeting with professionals and organizations working with NEETs,

- Organizing a meeting for general public where the results of the analysis from both countries will be presented – during the Slovenian visit in Norway,
- Conducting a peer review of the implemented project and writing a report about it; a trip to Slovenia.
