***Sverd i fjell**, *Swords in Rock*, consist of three large swords standing as a memory to the [battle](#) in Hafrsfjord about a 1000 years ago when King Harald Fairhair gathered all of Norway under one crown. The largest sword represents the victorious king, and the two smaller swords represent the defeated kings. The monument also represents peace, as the three swords are stuck in the hill and will never be used again.
